The start end of the pool is sixteen feet zero inches (16' 0") deep and the turn end is three feet five inches (3' 5") deep. Lanes are separated by Kiefer anti-wave lane lines. The touchpads are Colorado Aquagrips non-slip. The timing system is Daktronics Omnisport 6000 with an eight (8) lane readout video board. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

\* = Approximate times: Warm-up will begin immediately after the conclusion of the morning session, but not before 11:30 AM. All events are Positive Check-In. Check-In will close 20 minutes after the start of warm-up. The meet will begin 1 hour after the start of warm-up.

## **RULES AND SAFETY**

All current USA Swimming and ISI Rules and Regulations apply. ISI and USA swimming safety rules will be strictly enforced. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.
- All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club always has proper supervision. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Illinois Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Illinois and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in this Illinois Swimming competition to promote such competitions.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

All swimmers must be current (2024) members of USA Swimming. USA swimming deck registrations will not be accepted. A swimmer's age for the meet will be their age as of June 1, 2024.

## **MAAPP**

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a Page 2 of 8 condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. All current USA Swimming and ISI Rules and Regulations apply. ISI and USA Swimming safety rules will be strictly enforced. USA Swimming Rule 202.3.4 Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.

## **COACHES**

All coaches must be currently registered with USA Swimming and must provide proof of current registration at all sessions of the meet.

## **ENTRIES**

The Entry Chairperson will accept entries beginning at **9:00 AM, Tuesday, April 23, 2024** until the meet is full, but no later than **Tuesday, May 21, 2024 at 12:00 PM**. Email entries to [aclementi@alligatoraquatics.org](mailto:aclementi@alligatoraquatics.org). Entries will be accepted in the order received until the time limit per session is met. Thereafter, entries shall be returned promptly to the swimmer or team. An attempt will be made to achieve balance between age group classes.

We will use Hy-Tek Meet Manager for Windows. A completed and signed Summary Fee / Release Form provided in this packet and payment in full must accompany all entries. Checks are to be made payable to Alligator Aquatics.

## **ENTRY FEES**

\$6.00 per Individual Event

\$16.00 per Relay Event

\$24.00 Surcharge per swimmer

- Broken down as follows: \$10.00 Admissions, \$12.00 Facility surcharge, \$2.00 Illinois Swimming

## **FORMAT**

All events in this meet will be timed final events. Flyover starts will be used. Swimmers may be asked to report to a bullpen with multiple staging points before going behind the blocks for all events. Any procedures requiring the use of masks will be based on facility and municipality restrictions at the time of the meet. These procedures will be clearly explained at the coaches meeting. Events 400 yards or longer may be combined by age, gender, or both at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Meet management breaks may be inserted and removed at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

## **EVENTS**

Each swimmer may swim a maximum of four events per day. The 400 IM, 400 Free, and 800 free will be swum fastest to slowest. The host club reserves the right to limit events so as to fit the timeline. In accordance with USA Swimming Rules, Articles 105 and 202.2.13, the Meet Referee has the authority to accommodate swimmers with disabilities. It is the responsibility of the coaches or swimmers to contact the Meet Referee, prior to competition, with specific requests.

## **POSITIVE CHECK-IN**

Coaches will be required to check in their athletes. Check in will close 20 minutes after the start of each warm up session.

## **RESULTS**

Results will be emailed out to attending teams, Illinois Swimming, and will be available online for two weeks on the [meet landing page](#).

## **WARM-UP**

All Illinois Swimming warm-up and safety procedures will be in effect. The host club will post additional warm-up information on their website as needed.

## **AWARDS**

Individual swimmers in the 10 & Under, and 11-12 age groups will receive awards for 1st-8th place. Deck entries will not be permitted.

**ADMISSIONS**

Admissions are included in the swimmer surcharge. At the time of publication, spectators will be allowed to attend. The host team reserves the right to change the spectator policy in accordance with UIC policies at the time of the meet.

**TIMERS**

Participating teams may be required to supply two timers each session. Athletes in distance events (Ev. 23, 24, 67) will be required to supply their own timers and counters (Ev. 67).

**CONCESSIONS**

Food and beverages will be available. However, pool rules do not allow food outside the concession area. No glass containers of any kind will be allowed inside the pool complex or the adjoining building. No smoking or consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed anywhere on the facility grounds. These rules will be strictly enforced. Any violation could result in the expulsion of a swimmer and/or team from the meet.
