Lanes are 7' 4" wide with 6-inch Kiefer Wave Eater Lane Lines and Kiefer Elite Starting Platforms. Equipped with a fully automatic Colorado timing system and display. Watch backups for each lane will be used. The Meet host will ensure the required course dimensions.

Events 400 yards or longer may be combined by age, gender or both at the discretion of the Meet Management. Breaks may be inserted and removed at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

* = Approximate times: Warm-ups will begin immediately after the conclusion of the morning session, but not before 12:00 PM. All events are Positive Check In. Check In will close 20 minutes after the start of warm-ups. The meet will begin 1 hour after the start of warm-up.

RULES AND SAFETY

All current USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming Rules and Regulations apply. Wisconsin Swimming and USA swimming safety rules will be strictly enforced. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.
- All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club always has proper supervision. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of Wisconsin Swimming and the meet host under the conditions authored by Wisconsin and USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in this Wisconsin Swimming competition to promote such competitions.
- Deck changes are prohibited.

ELIGIBILITY

All entered swimmers must be current (2025) athlete members of USA Swimming, in good standing. A swimmer's age as of December 6, 2025 will determine their age for the meet. No on deck registrations will be allowed.

MAAAP

All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is over 18 years of age who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to SWIMS. This includes participation as a member of a relay. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1.

COACHES

All coaches must be currently registered with USA Swimming in good standing and must provide proof of current registration at all sessions of the meet.

ENTRIES

The Entry Chairperson will accept entries beginning at **9:00 AM (CT), Tuesday, Oct. 21, 2025** until the meet is full, but no later than **Tuesday, Nov. 25, 2025 at 12:00 PM (CT)**. Email entries to entries@alligatoraquatics.org. Entries will be accepted in the order received until the time limit per session is met. Thereafter, entries shall be returned promptly to the swimmer or team. An attempt will be made to achieve balance between age group classes.

We will use Hy-Tek Meet Manager for Windows. All entries must be accompanied by a hard copy printout of your Commlink entry data file or your information filled out on the entry form provided by Alligator Aquatics within this packet. A completed and signed Summary Fee / Release Form provided in this packet and payment in full must accompany all entries. Checks are to be made payable to Alligator Aquatics.

FORMAT

All events in this meet will be timed final events. Flyover starts will be used. Athletes swimming 25 yard events will be starting from the bulkhead end of the course. Swimmers may be asked to report to a bullpen with multiple staging points before going behind the blocks for all events. These procedures will be clearly explained at the coaches meeting. Events 400 yards or longer may be combined by age, gender, or both at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Meet management breaks may be inserted and removed at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

EVENTS

Each swimmer may swim a maximum of four events per day and one relay. No unattached swimmers may swim in relays. The 1000, 400 IM and 500 free will be swum fastest to slowest. The host club reserves the right to limit events so as to fit the timeline. Swimmers in distance events (Ev. 25, 26, 55, 56, and 111) will be required to provide their own timer and counter (if applicable).

DISABILITY SWIMMERS

In accordance with USA Swimming Rules Articles 105 and 202.2.13, the Meet Referee has the authority to accommodate swimmers with disabilities. Coaches and/or athletes shall present an [accommodation/modification form](#) to the Meet Director or Meet Referee to assist with any athlete requests.

RESULTS

Results will be emailed out to attending teams, Wisconsin Swimming, and will be available online for two weeks on the Meet Landing Page.

POSITIVE CHECK-IN

Coaches will be required to check in their athletes. Check in will close 20 minutes after the start of each warm up session.

WARM-UP

Circle swimming only, except in designated lanes and times. All entry to pools during open warm-up cool down periods shall be feet first entry from the start end. No snorkels, kickboards or other training devices are allowed during warm-ups. Teams should plan to do starts, sprint and pace work within their assigned warm-up time. Swimmer(s) without a coach present are to report to the Meet Director prior to warm-ups for lane assignment.

AWARDS

Individual swimmers and relays in the 8 & Under, 9-10 and 11-12 age groups will receive ribbons for 1st-8th place. Deck entries will not be permitted.

ADMISSIONS

No admissions will be charged at the RecPlex Aqua Arena. Admissions are included in the \$26.00 per swimmer surcharge charge. Participating teams may be required to supply two timers each session. At the time of publication, spectators will be allowed to attend. The host team reserves the right to change the spectator policy in accordance with RecPlex policies at the time of the meet.

CONCESSIONS

Food and beverages may be available. However, pool rules do not allow food outside the concession area. No glass containers of any kind will be allowed inside the pool complex or the adjoining building. No smoking or consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed anywhere on the facility grounds. These rules will be strictly enforced. Any violation could result in the expulsion of a swimmer and/or team from the meet.

MEDICAL SUPERVISION

Report injuries to the Lifeguard Staff and Meet Director. A first aid kit is located outside of the Lifeguard office. Only authorized Rec Plex staff may administer care using this kit.
